
### Sentences

- 5. He is not only a singer, but also a boxer...Cpd
- 6. This is the house that Jack built. .....Cpx.
- 7. He paid off his brother's debt. ......Sim
- 8. He died in his native village. ......Sim

# Sentence ? > 2 Simple S. = Compound Sen.

- He is poor <u>but</u> he is honest.
- Dang was sick ; he didn't work yesterday.
- Dang was sick : he didn't work yesterday.
- Sombat was writing, Tom was reading, Nikky was doing exercise.
- I don't know this man; I don't trust him.
- Do what you are told, <u>otherwise</u> you'll be punished.
- Mary is tired <u>and</u> hungry too.
- Robert worked well, <u>yet</u> he failed.







- Tony works <u>as if he were a machine.</u>
- There was no one <u>but</u> admired him.
- ✤He will go <u>wherever</u> she lives.
- Do you know how she did it.
- The tree of which the leaves are yellow is dying.
- **\***Wait here <u>until</u> I come.

↔ Main + Subor. = Complex Sen.

(1 Indep. + 1 Dep.)





I saw no one in the house which you had told me, so I didn't go in.

- I couldn't remember what his name is, but I will ask him.
- He lost the radio which he borrowed from me, so he couldn't face with me again.
- ↔→ Mixed S.=2 Independent + dep.
- Compound-Complex

Combination of Sentences	
Simple	Compound
<u>Besides making a</u> promise, he keeps it.	He <u>not only</u> makes a promise, <u>but also</u> he keeps it.
<u>Without working hard</u> , he will not get promotion.	He must work hard, <u>or</u> he will not get promotion
You must confess your fault to escape being executed.	You must confess your fault, <u>or</u> you will be executed.
<u>Beside a singer,</u> he is also a boxer.	He is <u>not only</u> a singer <u>but</u> <u>also</u> a boxer.

## Combination of Sentences



Simple	Complex
Bangkok <u>, the capital of Thailand</u> , is situated on the left bank of the Chao Praya River.	Bangkok <u>, which is the</u> capital of Thailand, is situated on the left bank of the Chao Praya River. (Adj. Cl.)
<u>On reaching home,</u> they went to bed.	As soon as they reached home, they went to bed. (Adv. Cl.)
I have money <u>to spare</u> you.	I have money <u>that I can</u> <u>spare you</u> . (Adj. Cl.)

Combination of Sentences	
Compound	Complex
Speak the truth, <u>and</u> you needn't have any fear.	If you speak the truth, you needn't have any fear.
He is very lazy, <u>so</u> he always fails.	He always fails because he is very lazy.
Walk quickly, <u>or</u> you will miss the train.	Unless you walk quickly, you will miss the train.

Combination of Sentences	
Complex	Simple
These are <u>what I require</u> .	These are <u>my</u> <u>requirement</u> . (N. CI.→N.)
Tell me <u>where she lives</u> .	Tell me her <u>address</u> .
She wants to know what my name is.	She wants to know my <u>name</u> .
He died in the village where he was born.	He died in his <u>native</u> village. (Adj.CI→Adj.)
No one is <u>so</u> old that he cannot learn.	No one is <u>too</u> old <u>to</u> learn.



**Transform into Compound/Complex Sentence** 

- 1. In spite of his failure, 1. .... he was not sorry. ....
- 2. He is wealthy, but he 2. is never happy.
- 3. Owing to his bad health, he cannot work hard.



**Transform into Compound/Complex Sentence** 

- In spite of his failure, 1. He failed <u>but</u> he was he was not sorry. not sorry.
- 2. He is wealthy, but he 2. <u>Though</u> he is is never happy. wealthy, he is never happy.
- 3. Owing to his bad health, he cannot work hard.
- 3. He is in bad health, and so he cannot work hard.

Type of Sim. S.	Sample
Decarative S.	We are MCU. students. He will be back here in a few minute
Negative S.	I <u>don't</u> live in Chiang Mai.
Interrogative S.	Does he owe this house?
Imperative S.	<b><u>Be</u> quite in the library.</b> <u>Please</u> open the window
Exclamation S.	There goes the bus! How cold it is!
